This has reference to your letter dated 07 March 2020 together with your application for the issue of Certificate of Acceptance (QCAA Form 16), proposed QCAA Supplement, Qatar Airways Letter of Intent, copy of your held EASA Maintenance Organisation Approval Certificate Ref.: BE.145.06, Maintenance Organisation Exposition and other relevant supporting documents in regard to the subject

We wish to inform you that based on the above and your held EASA Part-145 Approval Certificate Ref: BE.145.06., a QCAR 1003/2006 Article 7 Certificate of Acceptance Ref: QCAA/FAMO/250 is hereby issued to your organization in pursuance to State Law No. 15 of 2002, effective 23 July 2020. However, as a holder of the certificate, your organization will be audited by this Authority and pursuant to Article (40), Chapter 7 of Law 15 of 2002, State of Qatar Human Resources Law No. 15 of 2016 and Council of Ministers Decision No. 32 of 2016, all cost associated with the audit shall be borne by your organization consisting of the payment for the services of the QCAA Audit Team and round-trip airline tickets for the auditors. Please be advised that due to the global COVID-19 pandemic situation, we are not issuing invoices for the meantime. However, once the situation becomes manageable for conducting on-site audit, we will notify you of the proposed audit dates for your agreement and issue the relevant invoice for oversight inspection.

It is a condition to this approval, however, that the continuous validity of your held QCAR 1003/2006 Article 7 Certificate of Acceptance is subject to the satisfactory validation and final approval of your proposed QCAA MOE Supplement and result of the requisite QCAA audit at the approved location of your operation. This Authority may restrict, suspend, withdraw or revoke the approval should the organization fail to meet or comply with applicable requirements and established procedures or refrain from facilitating the conduct of inspection by the authorized inspectors, in pursuance to Article (40) of Law 15 of 2002. Pending final approval of your proposed QCAA MOE Supplement Revision Original Issue dated 16 July 2020, the same is hereby provisionally approved for your implementation.



Conditions:

3. Certificates of release to service for aircraft must quote the QCAA Certificate of Acceptance reference indicated above.
4. Subject to compliance with the foregoing conditions, this certificate shall remain valid, unless previously been surrendered, superseded, suspended or revoked.
